Here are some things every loss mom needs to get through the holidays:

- 1. Your presence: there is no fix; she just needs to know you are there.
- 2. Validation: acknowledge the holidays are hard without trying to fix it
- 3. Flexibility: traditions may be hard for her. Understand her feelings and plans may change last minute.
- 4. No expectations: her whole world has been turned upside down and she may not be able to show up the way she used tp. Keep your expectations low and allow her to tell you what she needs.

Practical ways to show up:

- 1. Send a text to let her know you are thinking of her and her baby.
- 2. Light a candle for her baby and send her a picture.
- 3. Send a card that includes her baby's name.
- 4. If she asks her friends and family to do something specific to help her honor her baby through the holidays, do your best to participate.
- 5. Invite her with no pressure to come.
- 6. Offer speicif help: grief groceries are always a good idea



Tip: use her baby's name throughout the holiday season whenever possible. It is not going to remind her that her baby is dead; it is going to remind her that her baby lived and that people remember them.



What not to do:

- Silence: This is isolating and makes her feel like her baby has been forgotten.
- Grief cliches: everything happens for a reason, be grateful for what you have, your baby would want you to be happy, etc
- Don't force participation in holiday traditions.
- Don't take it personally if she can't show up or has to leave early.

- A handwritten card or letter for her baby's stocking
- Personalized garden flag
- Personalized candle
- Garden stone
- Sun catcher
- Tshirt/hoodie from a pregnancy and infant loss nonprofit

- Baby's birth flower
- Family portrait that includes baby that died
